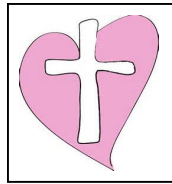

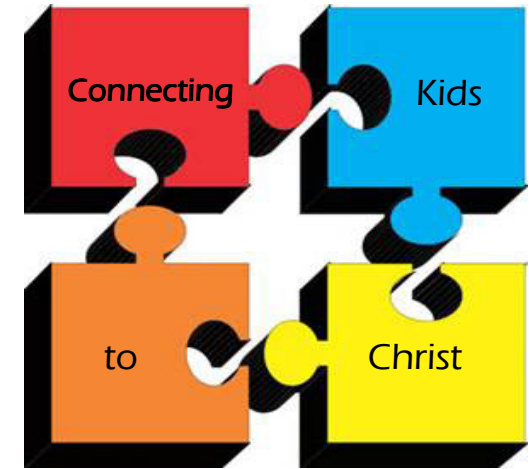

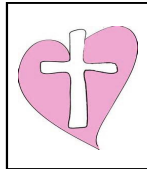
We have many opportunities for children and families to learn, worship, and fellowship together. We have highlighted many of those opportunities here.

Children's Sunday School

Our Sunday School classes are designed to provide a safe, nurturing, environment which allows children to explore their relationship with God. Our dedicated teachers love the Lord and love children! They enthusiastically share Bible stories, activities, and prayers that foster the development of your child's faith. These Sunday School classes are for children 4 years old through 6th grade. Older youth in 7th through 12th grade are encouraged to attend Sunday School in the youth room.

943 Children's Church

(4 years old through 4th grade)

943 Children's Church is an option for families with children who attend our 943 worship service. Children are dismissed during announcement time to the Covenant Kids room for worship, songs, and activities. Our dedicated children's worship leaders love sharing the Good News about Jesus!

Nursery

(Birth through 3 years old)

In our nursery, little ones are well cared for by our highly trained nursery nanny, with support provided by loving adult and youth volunteers. Our safe, well equipped nursery is available **Sunday morning from 9:30 to noon.**

Sacrament Training

This opportunity is designed to prepare third grade children to share in the Sacrament of Communion. Communion and Baptism are the two sacraments we celebrate in the Presbyterian Church. We use a multisensory approach to explore the two in depth. Bible study, games, art activities, and even special food are used to make a memorable class experience. The final activity is to bake the Communion bread which will be served to the congregation during a communion service. The children completing Sacrament training also share communion with the congregation on that special day. Sacrament training class meets once a month on Sunday mornings, 9:00-10:45 from October –May.

Covenant Kids Choir

The Covenant Kids choir sings periodically in worship services. Darla Pepper Miller, Director of Music Ministry, leads the children in singing and in hand bells. Rehearsals begin toward the end of September. Watch for a schedule in the bulletin, the Messenger newsletter, or as a hand out during Sunday School.
