1. Purpose of the Committee

  - a. Recruit targeted and motivated members to join this new Task Force
3. Given recommendations provided by the Ministry Architects, this Task Force will address the immediate needs of the children and youth ministries
  - a. Orient Renovation Team to their responsibilities
  - b. Assign Renovation Team members responsibilities for implementing recommendations from the Ministry Architects report
  - c. Develop a long term plan to meet the current and future needs of these ministries
  - d. Develop a job description for the leaders and volunteers and provide training opportunities
  - e. Develop an on-going volunteer list
  - f. Open communication between the Renovation Team, staff members, and the session members
4. Enlist experienced and professional coaches through the Ministry Architects to guide the task force during this renovation process
5. Continue to provide age appropriate educational and fellowship opportunities for children and youth during this transition time.
